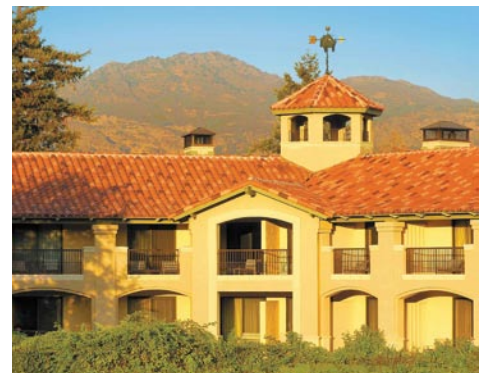
DIRECTIONS & TRANSPORTATION

FROM SAN FRANCISCO AIRPORT AND SAN FRANCISCO

Take Hwy 101 North to San Francisco. Take I-80 East across the Bay Bridge toward Sacramento and cross the Carquinez Bridge. After five miles, exit at Hwy 37 West for 2 miles to Hwy 29. Turn north (right) onto Hwy 29 and continue north for 20 miles to Yountville. Exit Hwy 29 at Madison St. The Napa Valley Lodge is on the corner of Madison and Washington Streets.

FROM THE OAKLAND AIRPORT

Take Hegenberger Rd. to 880 North. Follow 880 toward Oakland. Take I-80 East toward Sacramento and cross the Carquinez Bridge. After five miles, exit at Hwy 37 West and go 2 miles to Hwy 29. Turn north (right) onto Hwy 29 and continue north for 20 miles to Yountville. Exit Hwy 29 at Madison St. The Napa Valley Lodge is on the corner of Madison and Washington Streets.



FROM SACRAMENTO AIRPORT

Take I-5 South toward Sacramento. Take I-80 West toward San Francisco. After 50 miles, exit at Hwy 12 West (Napa/Sonoma) and go 8 miles to Hwy 29. Turn north (right) onto Hwy 29 and continue north for 12 miles to Yountville. Exit Hwy 29 at Madison St. The Napa Valley Lodge is on the corner of Madison and Washington Streets.

ACCOMMODATIONS

The Lodge has 55 guest rooms, including five suites, nearly all with views of the adjacent vineyard. A complete renovation of all guest bathrooms was finished in 2007, with walk-in glass showers, granite vanities and limestone floors. In addition, flat panel TVs, deluxe honor bars and new bedding were added to all rooms. Graciously furnished and spacious, all rooms feature terraces or balconies with panoramic views, seating areas, complimentary wireless Internet access, and most have wood-burning fireplaces and vaulted ceilings. Five luxury suites feature whirlpool bathtubs and separate walk-in glass showers plus an extra large seating area.

The Lodge's grounds were also completely renovated in 2007, and now feature an inviting area to enjoy at any time of day. The highlights of the newly landscaped courtyard include a new bocce court, outdoor fire pit, and outdoor food service area, where the complimentary continental breakfast is served weather permitting. To augment



the Lodge's full menu of in-room spa treatments, there is a new dedicated spa treatment room for single use or couples. In addition, there is a year-round heated pool and whirlpool spa.
